1. Dip apples in honey. Say the *bracha* for tree fruit and then eat!

Blessed are you, Lord our God, Ruler of the universe, Who creates the fruit of the tree.

Barukh atah Adonai Eloheynu melech ha-olam boray p'ri ha'eytz.

2, Rosh Hashanah prayer for renewal:

May it be Your will, Lord our God and God of our ancestors, that You renew for us a good and sweet year.

3 If this is the first bite of apples & honey this year, add the *Shehecheyanu* (prayer of gratitude): Blessed are You, Lord our God, Ruler of the universe, Who has kept us alive, sustained us, and enabled us to reach this season.
